Veterans Memorial Park is located on the corner of Concord Street and Guadacanal Road, across the street from the Framingham District Court.

The park offers flags, walkways, plantings, shade trees, and benches to sit and observe the beautiful Victory sculpture by Emilius R. Ciampa.

This park, originally built in 1952 to honor those who served our country, was renovated and re-dedicated on November 11, 2021.

The renovation included replacing benches, renovating the walkway and lawn, installing flag poles with lights, and rejuvenating the Victory sculpture.

A large part of this renovation was the addition of personalized bricks that line the main concourse into the Park.

The public is invited to purchase personalized bricks to be added to the concourse.

Bricks will be added twice a year in May & November.

IMPORTANT BRICK INFORMATION

Become a permanent part of Veterans Memorial Park by donating a commemorative brick to be placed along the main concourse in the park. You do not need to be a Framingham resident to donate a brick. You can dedicate it to a fallen hero, service member, family member, someone special, Military Branch, or place your own information on it.

Each 6" x 9" brick accepts up to 4-lines of text with 17 characters per line. (spaces & punctuation count as characters) All text will be printed in capital letters and centered on the brick.

Please fill the inscription as you wish for it to appear on the brick.

PLEASE NOTE:

- Bricks will be added to Veterans Memorial Park twice a year in May & November.
 - To meet the May deadline, payment and dedication forms must be received no later than April 1
 - To meet the November deadline, payment and dedication forms must be received no later than September 15

- You will be notified when your brick has been placed.
